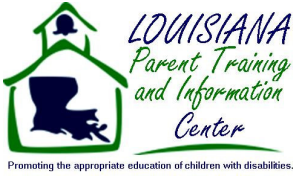

The 3 P's of Testing: Plan, Prepare, Pass!

BEFORE this year's LEAP, GEE, ACT, SAT tests.**

Who should attend?

- * **Parents of students with disabilities, family members/caregivers;**
- * **Students with disabilities;**
- * **Professionals who teach or support students with disabilities**

Why? Participation will increase the likelihood of greater success by students with disabilities during test taking this Spring.

What? PowerPoint presentations and interactive discussions.

Training 1: 3 Ps of Testing: Plan, Prepare, Pass! On LEAP. We'll cover:

- **Accommodations and modifications- what are they?;**
- **How is it decided which students with disabilities will take LEAP?**
- **Determining what accommodations are allowable;**
- **Determining what is listed on your student's IEP or S.504 IAP (individualized accommodation plan);**
- **Learning by when accommodations and modifications must be included on IEP or IAP so that they can be provided during LEAP.**
- **Developing a plan that will consider:**
 - How to support the student to be aware of changes in school schedules; typical activities and to become knowledgeable about how testing will be conducted, including the accommodations to be provided to reduce the likelihood of student behavior that would interfere with test taking.**
- **How to establish communication between school and home to ensure that plans are followed.**
- **What parents can do at home to support the student.**
- **What happens if the student does not pass?**

Training 2: 3 P's of Testing: Plan, Prepare, Pass On GEE (10th grade LEAP), ACT, SAT including:

- **The topics listed above for LEAP classes & accommodations;**
- **Information on what is required by ACT, SAT in order to provide accommodations/modifications during ACT,SAT;**
- **Self Advocacy/Self Determination Skills;**
- **Learning more about the student's rights under the ADA & S.504 in post secondary educational settings;**
- **Information on Transition into Adulthood**
